## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Council Member Kino Kane has come before the Tribal Council to request financial assistance so that Marion Patterson, daughter of Cynthia Burnette, will be able to participate in the April 14-20 educational trip to Washington, D.C. sponsored by the Close Up Foundation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the cost of the trip is \$997.00 per student; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes such educational experiences are in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache youth.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes \$997.00 to be used for Marion Patterson to participate in the Close Up Foundation sponsored trip to Washington, D.C. April 14-20, 1991.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that said funds will be made available from the Carrizo Community Land Claim Funds.

The foregoing resolution was on March 5, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
