## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. Eddie Gloshay has come before the Tribal Council on behalf of the Native American Church of Apacheland and has requested Tribal Council assistance in obtaining a Charter for the Native American Church of Apacheland to conduct services on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, after discussion, Mr. Gloshay is advised that the Office of the Tribal Attorney will assist him in preparing Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws and a Charter for review by the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Office of the Tribal Attorney to assist Mr. Gloshay in the preparation of a Charter, Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws for a Chapter of the Native American Church of Apacheland to practice and conduct services within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation subject to final review and action by the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on March 14, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of five for and zero against and one abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
