WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with Mr. Endfield's request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes expenditure of \$100.00 to purchase graduation gifts for members of the White Mountain Apache tribe who are graduating this year from the Sherman Indian School in Riverside, California.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 05, 1991</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>one</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
