RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by Council Member Virgil Hinton that there is a great need for construction of a sewer system to serve existing homes and proposed new housing construction in the communities of Cedar Creek and Carrizo; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Hinton explains to the Council that many of the homes are still on septic tanks and that drinking water is being contaminated and other sanitation problems exists due to the communities lack of a sewer system; and
- WHEREAS, Council Member Hinton suggests that the Tribal Council request the Indian Health Service review existing Memorandum of Agreement and to estimate what funding would be necessary for construction of a sewer system for the communities of Cedar Creek and Carrizo so that all existing homes presently on septic tanks may be hooked into a sewer system which will also serve future housing construction; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, being aware of the sanitation and sewer problems in Cedar Creek and Carrizo, concurs with Mr. Hintons recommendation.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby requests the Indian Health Service
 to conduct an investigation and report back to the
 Office of the Tribal Chairman and that of Council
 Member Virgil Hinton, what funding would be necessary
 for construction of a sewer system for the communities
 of Cedar Creek and Carrizo so that all homes presently
 on septic tanks might be hooked into a sewer system;
 said estimates to include provision for future new
 housing construction for said communities.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 03, 1991</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) (i) (j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
