## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is recommended to the Tribal Council that there is a need for a Landlord and Tenant Act for reservation housing due to lack of guidelines and laws that could be applied by the Tribal Court in respect to landlord and tenant rights, duties and obligations; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Tribal Attorney's Office should draft a Landlord and Tenant Act for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and present it to the Tribal Council for its review.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Office of the Tribal Attorney to draft a Landlord and Tenant Act for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 03, 1991</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) (i) (q) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
