RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has just received a preliminary appraisal of the status of the existing Tribal Travel Regulations, and has determined that a more detail and complete analysis with recommendations be presented for review in the near future; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is also aware that the existing per diem and lodging rates in Section I and J of the Travel Regulations have not been updated since August 1983; and
- WHEREAS, the increase cost of lodging and meals in and out of state has created considerable hardship for employees traveling on behalf of the Tribe under the existing regulations such as employees using their own money, seeking waivers from the existing rates and accepting less than desirable accommodations; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is requested to temporarily amend the rates in Section I and J of the existing Tribal Travel Regulations to better accommodate employees until the entire Travel policies have been reviewed and amended (see attachment); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that the cost of lodging and meals has increased tremendously in recent years and therefore concurs with recommended rate increases of the existing Travel Regulations.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Treasurer to perform a more detail review and present a report on the actual status with recommendations of the Tribal Travel Regulations in the near future.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby approves all the recommended rate adjustments on a temporary basis, effective as of today, to be incorporated in Section I and J of the Tribal Travel Regulations until a more formal review is completed.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby reaffirms that all Tribal Travel Regulations shall remain in full force and effect except that otherwise specified here in the existing Travel Regulations.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
