## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Police Department desires to enter into a contract agreement with the State of Arizona Surplus Property Management Office and the U.S. General Service Administration in order to obtain surplus properties from them; and
- WHEREAS, the Arizona Surplus Property and Management Office and the U.S. General Service Administration (GSA) require a proper resolution from the governing tribal council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe granting permission for the White Mountain Apache Police Department to enter such a contract agreement with the Arizona Surplus Property Management Office and the U.S. General Service Administration.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
  Tribe that it hereby grants the White Mountain Apache
  Police Department permission to enter into a contract
  agreement with the State of Arizona Surplus Property
  Management Office and the U.S. General Services Administration for the purpose of obtaining needed
  surplus property, which will remain effective and
  perpetual until otherwise terminated by the State or
  GSA or withdrawal by the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby agrees to the terms, conditions, reservations, and restrictions in acquisition, utilization, and disposal of surplus property obtained through the Federal Surplus Property Donation Program.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that funds shall be made available and are available to pay for charges incidental to acquistion of surplus property through the federal donation program.
