## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- the TribaL Council has declared Wednesday, August 14, WHEREAS. 1991 as a day of mourning and remembrance for Council Member Virgil Hinton, Sr., who passed away August 12, 1991; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to acknowledge his devoted and selfless service to the White Mountain Apache Tribe, his constituents, family and friends and to honor his desire for a better world for everyone; and
- the Tribal Council as a tribute to Virgil Hinton, Sr., WHEREAS, wishes to assume all costs of funeral and burial including a casket, headstone, woodfencing and a flagpole for the gravesite and a beef for the wake.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby assumes the cost of the funeral and burial for Virgil Hinton, Sr., including the cost a casket, headstone, woodfencing around the gravesite, a flagpole and a beef for the wake.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it has assumed these expenses in honor of its departed son, father, fellow tribal member and colleague and in remembrance of his good deeds and works for the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on August 13, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
