WHEREAS, the McNary School District has requested authorization from the Tribal Council to place STOP signs wherever needed for the health, safety and protection of the school children in McNary; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised as to the necessity for said signs and concurs in the request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to the McNary School District to place STOP signs wherever needed in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of school children in the town of McNary.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 04, 1991</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h,i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
