RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by Resolution No. 01-91-13 directed the Tribal Council Secretary to post a proposed Extradition Ordinance amending Chapter Three of the Tribe's Criminal Code; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council Secretary advised the Council that said ordinance has been posted in accordance with that directive; and
- WHEREAS, the Council is further advised that no opposition has been voiced to final passage of said ordinance.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts Ordinance No. 168 amending Chapter Three of the Criminal Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 04, 1991</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>two</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (q) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
