

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Johnny and Pauline Endfield and family have requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of October 4 & 5, 1991; and

WHEREAS, Hupp, Jr. and Charlotte (Tessler) Sanchez have been chosen as Godparents, and they have accepted the role; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at the old Fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Johnny and Pauline Endfield, Sponsor, and Hupp, Jr. and Charlotte (Tessler) Sanchez, Godparents to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of October 4 & 5, 1991 at the old Fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on September 05, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (g) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
