RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member Andrea (Velasquez) Hopper has come before the Tribal Council on behalf of non-tribal member Flosee Velasquez with photographs showing the deterioration of her home; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Velasquez is an elder and a widow and based upon her testimony and the photographs submitted for Tribal Council review, the Council concludes that Mrs. Velasquez should receive help in rebuilding and renovating her home through various tribal programs through the office of the Tribal Chairman.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs the office of Tribal Chairman to assist Mrs. Flosee Velasquez in the renovation of her home to the extent possible pursuant to current tribal programs.

The foregoing resolution was on October 2, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
