## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member Lucille Willie has come before the Tribal Council and has advised that for many years Delano Dahkoshay allowed her to travel to her home on a road he had constructed near her home; and
- WHEREAS, she explained to the Council that he now has two houses and the road goes between those two houses and for personal reasons Mr. Dahkoshay has blocked the road forcing her to go around on a road that is in dire need of repair and is difficult to traverse; and
- WHEREAS, she has asked for assistance from the Tribal Council to improve the road to her residence which is along Power Line Road; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Bureau of Indian Affairs has equipment and should be able to assist her.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the Fort Apache Indian Agency, BIA Roads Department utilize its equipment to improve the road to Lucille Willie's residence.

The foregoing resolution was on October 02, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
