BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that tribal member Leon Clay be placed on the HIP priority list.

The foregoing resolution was on October 02, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
