RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Steven and Isla (Adley) Aday have applied for a tribal loan from Revolving Credit Program in order to purchase an existing house; and
- WHEREAS, Steven and Isla (Adley) Aday require a homesite lease; and
- WHEREAS, a homesite lease is required by Section 21 (3) 2 of the Declaration of Policies and Plan of Operation of the Revolving Credit Program approved by the Tribal Council on July 22, 1975; and
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves and grants a homesite lease to Steven and Isla (Adley) Aday for a period of twenty-five (25) years with an option for an additional term of twenty-five (25) years at the rate of \$1.00 for twenty-five (25) years, payable in advance on the first day of the month following the effective date of the lease.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Chairman shall execute said lease for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in accordance with Tribal Ordinance No. 44; the effective date of the commencement of said lease being the date of approval of the loan by the Secretary of the Interior or his designated representative.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Chairman shall approve the leasehold mortgage mortgaging the improvements to the White Mountain Apache Tribal Revolving Credit Program.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that should the loan not be finalized within one hundred eighty (180) days from the date hereof, the lease and approval of right to mortgage the leasehold improvements shall thereby automatically terminate.

The foregoing resolution was on October 02, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
