RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Alvino Hawkins, Sr. and his son Ronald Hawkins, have come before the Tribal Council with a request for financial assistance to enable Ronald, a Junior who attends the Southwest Indian School located in Peoria, Arizona, to go to Washington, D.C. and participate in the "Close Up" program, which is designed to provide students the opportunity to see how the Federal Government operates first hand; and
- WHEREAS, Ronald Hawkins has been recommended to participate, by the Superintendent of the Southwest Indian School, is involved in the Interact Club, is Junior Class Treasurer, and has participated in both soccer and basketball during his attendance at the school; and
- WHEREAS, the Superintendent of the Southwest Indian School has recommended Ronald Hawkins for the "Close Up" trip to Washington, D.C. this spring, and advises that Ronald has the potential to be a good leader; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that the cost of the week long trip in the spring of 1992, is approximately \$1,200.00 and financial assistance is requested in that amount; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in said request as the development of leadership potential of its youth is of primary importance to the Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Chairman Ronnie Lupe to appropriate \$1,200.00 in financial assistance to Ronald Hawkins from the contingency fund account to enable Ronald Hawkins to participate in the "Close Up Washington" trip scheduled Spring of 1992.

The foregoing resolution was on November 06, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
