RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member Iretta Taylay from Cibecue has come before the Tribal Council and requested that she be placed on the HIP Priority List; and
- WHEREAS, she explains to the Tribal Council that she lives in an old dilapidated house with no electricity in south Cibecue, and that the house is so far from a power source that it has not been economically feasible or possible to bring power to the house; and
- WHEREAS, Council member Judy Dehose advises the Council that Mrs. Taylay qualifies for HIP priority housing and the Tribal Council agrees.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that Iretta Taylay be placed on the HIP Priority List.

The foregoing resolution was on November 06, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
