RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, District IV Councilmember, Johnny Endfield, advises the Tribal Council that tribal members residing in the Alchesay Flats area are requesting installation of a pay phone at that site for health, safety and welfare reasons as the closest phone is in the Diamond Creek Community; and
- WHEREAS, many tribal members do not have private phones and a pay phone is a necessity for emergencies; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Endfield is requesting that the Tribal Council pass a resolution requesting Contel, not GTE, to install a pay phone at that area through his office, and the Tribal Council concurs in his request.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests the GTE Corporation to install a pay telephone at the Alchesay Flats residential area as soon as possible for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of that area.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes District IV Councilmember, Johnny Endfield, to contact GTE Corporation for the purpose of carrying out this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on November 06, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
