RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal members have come before the Tribal Council with a request that the Tribe provide transportation for Sunrise employees from the communities of Cibecue, Carrizo, and Cedar Creek; and
- WHEREAS, the Council is advised that many employees or persons who wish to work for Sunrise cannot afford the roundtrip transportation or lack transportation to the ski area; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to provide equal opportunity to persons from all communities to work at the Sunrise Ski Area regardless of remoteness from the ski area; and
- WHEREAS, General Manager, Raymond Endfield, Jr., explains that his budget, which was approved by the Tribal Council for FY 91/92 does not allow the purchase of a van for that purpose, although he is sympathetic with the request of the persons coming before the Council from those communities; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that grant funds should be investigated for the purchase of a van for Sunrise to transport employees from the communities of Cibecue, Carrizo and Cedar Creek.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby directs that District I and
 District II Councilmembers for the communities of
 Cibecue, Carrizo and Cedar Creek meet with General
 Manager Raymond Endfield, Jr. for the purpose of
 locating grant monies to purchase a van to transport
 employees from those communities to the Sunrise Ski
 Area.

The foregoing resolution was on November 06, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
