

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Election Commission has presented to the Tribal Council a certification of candidates who have presented petitions and have otherwise qualified to be nominated to an office in the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VIII, Sections 5 and 6 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe it is the responsibility of the Tribal Council to declare all qualified candidates as regularly nominated; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the certification presented by the Election Commission and accepts it as presented.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby declares those individuals whose names appear on the certification presented by the Election Commission, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference to be regularly nominated to the office which they seek in the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that these individuals shall have their names placed on the 1992 Primary Election Ballots of the White Mountain Apache Tribe as eligible candidates.

The foregoing resolution was on January 08, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VIII, Section 5 and 6 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


