RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Election Commission of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has certified the candidates for the Primary Election to be held on February 5, 1992 and the General Election will be held on April 1, 1992; and
- WHEREAS, the Primary Election will be held in Districts I, III and IV at Alchesay Hall, McNary Community Building, Canyon Day Community Building, Seven Mile Community Building, East Fork Community Building, and the Cibecue Gymnasium; and
- WHEREAS, the General Election will be held in District I, II, III and IV at Alchesay Hall, McNary Community Building, Canyon Day Community Building, Carrizo Community Building, Cedar Creek Community Building, Forestdale, Seven Mile Community Building, East Fork Community Building and the Cibecue Gymnasium; and
- WHEREAS, the above listed polling places are not all regularly used, and most if not all are in need of cleaning, renovation and repairs in order to be suitable for polling places, and some of the sites need utilities—water, electricity, and heating supplied as they are not currently furnished; and
- WHEREAS, it is the consensus of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the costs of such repairs, maintenance and utilities should be borne by the Tribal Maintenance and Tribal Utility Departments.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Maintenance and Tribal Utility should furnish and absorb the costs of the necessary repairs and utilities at the above-named polling places at the direction of the Election Commission so that the polling sites will be ready for the Primary Election on February 5, 1992 and the General Election on April 1, 1992

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 08, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>NINE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
