


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Kino Torino, Councilmember from District III comes before the council to request assistance to obtain rental housing in the East Fork area because there is a severe shortage of available housing in the East Fork area and many people are having to live with families and extended families in very crowded conditions; and
- WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the East Fork Community if there were available additional rental housing units to alleviate the housing shortage and overcrowded conditions in which some tribal members are living; and
- WHEREAS, it is requested that the Housing Authority construct 20 rental units in the East Fork area, there being land available; and
- WHEREAS, Kino Torino asks for the Tribal Council's support in having the Housing Authority construct rental units in the East Fork area; and
- WHEREAS, Kino Torino is willing and available to assist the Housing Authority in locating and setting aside the necessary land to construct the rental units requested; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is very aware of the housing shortage on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and believes that it would be advantageous to the community of East Fork and to the whole tribe to have 20 rental units constructed in East Fork.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it supports the proposal to construct 20 rental units in the East Fork area and that it will urge the Housing Authority to actively pursue this proposal.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Housing Authority should investigate and actively pursue funding to construct 20 rental units in East Fork to alleviate the severe housing shortage in the East Fork area.

The foregoing resolution was on January 08, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
