

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, tribal member Esther Crocker has come before the Tribal Council with a request that she be granted authorization to purchase lumber from FATCO to build her father, Thomas Ethelbah, a house; and

WHEREAS, she further expresses a need for bathroom fixtures and a hot water heater; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council after review of the circumstances concludes that Esther Crocker should be permitted to make monthly payments to purchase the lumber from FATCO estimated to cost approximately \$662.00 and that the Tribal Maintenance Department should be authorized to donate bathroom fixtures such as a toilet, tub, sink and hot water heater for the home.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the General Manger of FATCO to allow Esther Crocker to purchase \$662.00 worth of lumber and make a monthly payment of \$110.00 until paid in full.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Maintenance Department to donate necessary bathroom fixtures such as a toilet, tub, sink and hot water heater for the home.

The foregoing resolution was on March 11, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
