

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that future housing for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation is in jeopardy due to the delinquencies in the tenant account receivables; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that housing payments made through payroll deduction in a five month period were approximately \$12,000.00 short due to other payroll deductions being given priority over the housing payments; and
- WHEREAS, if said delinquencies continue, the Tribe will not receive further HUD funding for housing; and
- WHEREAS, it is the consensus of the Tribal Council that tribal housing is a priority and steps should be taken to cure the tenant account receivables delinquencies; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that payroll deduction for housing payments should be given priority over all other payroll deductions, except those deductions required by federal law.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that housing payments shall be given priority over all other payroll deduction payments.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Payroll Department, Tribal Treasurer, and Tribal Controller to carry out the directives of this resolution, effective upon receipt of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs that the Tribal Council Secretary distribute this resolution to each tribal enterprise manager.

The foregoing resolution was on March 11, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
