## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Cedar Creek Community has requested \$10,000 from the General Land Claims Fund in order to repair its rodeo arena; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in said request provided that the Cedar Creek Community provide the labor, equipment, and arrange for the implementation of the work without further requests from the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves and authorizes \$10,000 from the General Land Claims Fund to be paid to the Cedar Creek Community for the repair of the Cedar Creek Rodeo Arena with the condition that the Cedar Creek Community provide the labor, equipment, and undergo the necessary groundwork to implement the repairs without further requests to the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>March 18, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
