## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by the Tribal Attorney that the revisions have been made to the proposed Enrollment Code Ordinance as directed by the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the proposed Enrollment Code Ordinance is recommended as being in the best interest of the Office of Vital Records and the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs that said proposed ordinance should be posted in each district for a minimum of 10 days prior to final enactment by the Tribal Council as required by the Tribal Constitution; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs that the proposed Enrollment Code Ordinance should also be published in the Fort Apache Scout for public review and comment.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Council Secretary to post the proposed Enrollment Code Ordinance in each district for a minimum of 10 days as required by the Constitution in the form and content attached hereto.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Council Secretary to cause the proposed Enrollment Code Ordinance to be published in the Fort Apache Scout in the form and content attached hereto.

The foregoing resolution was on March 18, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of  $\underline{six}$  for and  $\underline{zero}$  against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
