A discussion was held on Janice Charley's land assignment. She said she doesn't have a road to her house and requested the Board to do something about it. She said her brother Aaron had already fenced his lot and she can't get in that way. She would like the a road through the lots in front of her house. Raymond Endfield and Johnny Endfield also requested to have a road put between the lots in front of house. The Board decided to invite all the people involved to the next meeting to discuss this. Loretta Dazen requested to have a farmland assigned to her in Cedar Creek. She said the land was loaned out to Rusty Cosay and now he is claiming it. The Board decided to have a special meeting for this also. (No date set)
