

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Tribal Councilmember, Judy Dehose requests that a tractor and plow be assigned and stationed at Cibecue; and

WHEREAS, this request is made in order to better serve the community of Cibecue; at this time, when either a tractor or plow are needed in Cibecue, someone must transport it to Cibecue from Whiteriver and back, which transportation takes valuable time and manpower, and such time would be better utilized in providing services to the Cibecue community; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe concurs with the request of Councilmember Judy Dehose to station a tractor and plow at Cibecue.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a tractor and plow shall be stationed at and assigned to Cibecue for use in that community.

The foregoing resolution was on April 24, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (h) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
