

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Article VIII of the Tribal Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe requires regular elections to be held for Tribal Council Members; and

WHEREAS, said Regular Election was held by the White Mountain Apache Tribe on Wednesday, April 1, 1992, wherein Tribal Council candidates submitted their names to a vote of the people for Council Offices in Districts I, II, III and IV; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Election Commission has certified to the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the general election is complete and has been carried out in accordance with provisions of the Tribal Constitution and Chapter 3 of the Government Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and has certified that of the total reservation-wide votes cast of 3,542 votes, the following number of votes were received by the individuals listed below whose names were on the ballot for the following offices:

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with the certification of Election results presented by the Tribal Election Commission and concludes that the Commission's certification should be affirmed and accepted by the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the certification of the election results submitted by the Tribal Election Commission for the Office of Council Representative for Districts I, II, III and IV are hereby accepted and the attached certification of election results is hereby incorporated into this resolution by reference herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the candidates who have been elected as Council Representatives and who will assume their respective Council offices on May 6, 1992 are as follows:
