

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS,** the White Mountain Apache Youth are a vital part of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Youth Council is a member of the United National Indian Tribal Youth with more than 1,000 Native American Youth from throughout the nation who will gather at the Radisson Hotel in St. Paul for Unity's Annual National Conference; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Youth Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe wants to take 20 youth and 2 adult sponsors to this conference designating first priority to current active youth council members to represent all of the reservation districts; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Youth Council requests that the Tribe cover airfare and motel expenses of \$8,700 and the Youth Council will cover registration and subsistence of \$3,630; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Youth Council is receiving national recognition and requests the foregoing funding for the opportunity for more training in the area of leadership development and exchange of ideas with Native Youth nation-wide and the Unity Conference will address these needs and concerns.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes \$8,700 to be given to the Tribal Youth Council from tribal funds for the purpose of attending the Unity Conference in St. Paul.


