

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Members of District IV, resident in the Whiteriver communities of Chinatown, Another World, Smurf Village and Four Corners have brought to the attention of the Tribal Council the lack of recreational facilities available to the children and members of those communities by way of the attached Petition; and

WHEREAS, the community members request that District IV Councilmembers meet with them and discuss the feasibility of recreation sites within the above-named Whiteriver housing communities, to determine where and how such recreational facilities should be constructed; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe concurs with the request of the Community members and recommends that District IV Councilmembers meet with community members and reach a solution and consensus regarding the site and construction of playgrounds and recreational facilities for the Whiteriver housing communities of Chinatown, Another World, Smurf Village and Four Corners.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that District IV councilmembers should meet with community representatives from Chinatown, Another World, Smurf Village and Four Corners to determine the feasibility and location of recreational facilities and playgrounds for those communities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that District IV Council members should report their findings, suggestions and solutions to the Tribal Council at the next regularly scheduled Council Meeting.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1992 duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
