


**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council by previous Resolution No. 04-92-098 approved Hupp, Jr. and Charlotte (Tessler) Sanchez's request to sponsor a Sunrise Dance during the week-end of June 5-7, 1992 to be held at the old fairgrounds in Whiteriver; and
- WHEREAS,** Charlotte Sanchez has informed the Council Secretary that Marvin and Levinia (Dehose) Brawley have been chosen as Godparents and that they have accepted the role; and
- WHEREAS,** Mrs. Sanchez further advises that the date has now been changed to the week-end of July 10-12, 1992, and has requested that the prior resolution be amended to reflect this information.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache that Resolution No. 04-92-098 is hereby amended by changing the date of the Sunrise Dance to "the week-end of July 10-12, 1992" to be held at the old fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on May 07, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of five for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (g) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
