


**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Wilson Benally and Barbara (Sanchez) Benally request that their children's, Twyla Cheyenne Benally and Williamson Benally, tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that they will become eligible for enrollment with the Navajo Tribe; and


WHEREAS, the necessary documents of relinquishment of headrights were read and signed by the parents, Wilson Benally and Barbara (Sanchez) Benally in the presence of a Notary Public on the 7th day of April, 1992 and are attached hereto.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants relinquishment of White Mountain Apache tribal membership to Twyla Cheyenne and Williamson Benally as requested by their parents, Wilson and Barbara (Sanchez) Benally.

The foregoing resolution was on May 20, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of five for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III Section 3 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

I, Williamson L. Benally, an enrolled member of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, do hereby, on my own free will, and adult and knowledgeable of making this decision voluntarily, request the TRIBAL COUNCIL of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION, WHITERIVER, ARIZONA, to release me from the Tribal Census Rolls of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to enable me to enroll with the Navajo Tribe

Further, I realize that I will no longer have fishing or hunting privileges on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; no homesite or farmland assignments, or claim to have title to any resources of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, or monies distributed pursuant to Judgment under the Indian Claims Commission Act.
