

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


- WHEREAS,** tribal member David Kitcheyan, has come before the Tribal Council and requested that the house located at 23 Pine Street, previously leased to his In-laws, Juan and Rose Pacheco be turned over to his daughter, Chadeen Kitcheyan; and
- WHEREAS,** Mr. Kitcheyan advises the Tribal Council that on March 30, 1989, Juan and Rose Pacheco did turn over the house to their granddaughter, Chadeen Kitcheyan in a notarized statement, attached hereto; and
- WHEREAS,** Mr. Kitcheyan is advised by the Tribal Council that previous requests for houses have been granted at McNary with the understanding that the land underneath the house remains with the Tribe and that no land assignments are being granted for the houses due to future plans for commercial development of the area; and
- WHEREAS,** Mr. Kitcheyan acknowledges that information from the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council concludes that Chadeen Kitcheyan should be given the house at 23 Pine Street and that the entire responsibility for maintenance and repairs shall be hers.
- BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby transfers and assigns title to the house located at 23 Pine Street to Chadeen Kitcheyan as her personal property.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that no land assignments be made for the land upon which the house presently stands until further notice by the Tribal Council as land comprising the McNary townsite and land adjacent thereto have been designated as a commercial development area.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that the Legal Department is directed to prepare the necessary Bill of Sale or appropriate legal document to evidence that title to 23 Pine Street has been transferred to Chadeen Kitcheyan.

The foregoing resolution was on June 04, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of five for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
