

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** Wilson and Barbara (Sanchez) Benally requested that their child, Chuck Ledoux Benally's tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so the child may become eligible for enrollment in the Tribe of his father which is the Navajo Tribe of Window Rock, Arizona; and

**WHEREAS,** the necessary documents of relinquishment of headrights were read and signed by the parents, Wilson and Barbara (Sanchez) Benally in the presence of a Notary Public on the 7th day of April, 1992 and are attached hereto.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the Tribal Relinquishment request from the parents of Chuck Ledoux Benally, and his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe is granted relinquished this date.

The foregoing resolution was on June 05, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 3 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

I, Chuck L. Benally, an enrolled member of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, do hereby, on my own free will, and adult and knowledgeable of making this decision voluntarily, request the TRIBAL COUNCIL of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION, WHITERIVER, ARIZONA, to release me from the Tribal Census Rolls of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to enable me to enroll with the Navajo Tribe

Further, I realize that I will no longer have fishing or hunting privileges on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; no homesite or farmland assignments, or claim to have title to any resources of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, or monies distributed pursuant to Judgment under the Indian Claims Commission Act.
