


**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


**WHEREAS,** Councilmember Herbert Tate has requested Tribal Council approval to grant a right-of-way to Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc. for installation of a utility pole at the Canyon Day Basketball Court in order to provide lighting at night; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council concludes that a right-of-way should be granted.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants a right-of-way to the Navopache Electric Coop. Inc. for the purpose of installing a utility pole at the Canyon Day Basketball Court in order to provide lighting during night games.

The foregoing resolution was on June 5, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (e) (h) (i) (m) (u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
