

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs maintains a listing of all roads on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for which they have a responsibility and is referred to as the BIA Roads System; and

WHEREAS, road mileage on the BIA Road System is used in a formula for funding road maintenance monies; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to update this list from time to time to insure that the Tribe receives its full entitlement to these monies.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache that the following described roads totalling approximately 15.2 miles be added to the BIA system:


<u>ROUTE</u>	<u>MILES</u>	<u>DESCRIPTION</u>
1	+6.2	WHITERIVER - Add; W. Whiskey Flats, W. Diamond Creek (Stomp Dr.), Alchesay Flats (Goklish Dr.), N.E. Diamond Creek, lower Over-The-Rainbow, Diamond Creek Frontage, and the Hoffman/Harrina Street.
2	+0.7	FORT APACHE - Add; 7-mile (Sha-na-na Dr.), Little Cedar Creek.
4	+2.2	CANYON DAY - Add; W. Canyon Day Subdivision, W. Fort Apache Subdivision.
6	+0.2	CEDAR CREEK - Add; Altaha Drive.
7	+1.1	SEVEN MILE - Add; Seven Mile Subdivision.
11	+0.3	HONDAH - Add; Hondah Village Streets.
310	+4.5	CIBECUE - Add; AZ 16-27 Subdivision, Assembly of God turn-out; W. Cibecue Subdivision.
