RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the governing body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to obtain further information concerning the current health status of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Nathan J. Clifford, M.D., Cardiologist Phoenix Indian Medical Center, Phoenix, Arizona, proposes to conduct a research study of the coronary artery disease and hypertension in the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, this project is to serve as a subsequent study to an initial research work conducted in 1957-58.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to Dr. Nathan J. Clifford to begin the study of the tribe's coronary artery disease and hypertension.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Dr. Nathan J. Clifford provide progress reports on a regular basis to the Tribal Health Authority.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 09, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
