FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


**WHEREAS,** Resolution No. 06-92-168 has been returned without BIA action because it was not filed with the Agency Superintendent within the ten (10) day time limitation prescribed by the Tribe's Constitution; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council concludes that said resolution should be re-enacted.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms and re-enacts Resolution No. 06-92-168 in its entirety.

The foregoing resolution was on July 21, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of five for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
