## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, District III Councilmember Randall Massey, Jr. on behalf of the Seven Mile community, has verbally presented a petition from the community requesting authorization from the Tribal Council to withdraw \$235.97 from the Seven Mile Land Claims fund to pay for the Turkey Creek rodeo ground and Seven Mile Basketball court electric bills; and
- WHEREAS, Councilmember Massey avows that he will file a written community petition with signatures to the Tribal Council Secretary in the very near future; and
- WHEREAS, a copy of the electric bills are attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference herein; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with this request.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the withdrawal of \$235.97 from the Seven Mile Land Claims fund for the purpose of paying the attached bills for Turkey Creek rodeo ground and Seven Mile Basketball court.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 12, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>five</u> for and <u>one</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
