- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that Mr. Albert James Titla, DOB: 03-07-1974, has requested enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee has completely reviewed Mr. Albert James Titla's request and supporting documents; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee finds Mr. Titla eligible for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe and possesses the necessary blood quantum of 1/2 White Mountain Apache through his mother, Veronica (Burnette) Titla; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Albert James Titla, has been a resident of San Carlos, Arizona; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Albert James Titla has provided official relinquishment documents of his enrollment with the San Carlos Apache Tribe to the Office of Vital Records.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that based upon the recommendation of the Tribal
 Enrollment Committee, that Mr. Albert James Titla is
 hereby granted membership into the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 12, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III Section 3 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
