


**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


- WHEREAS,** Randall Massey, Jr. Councilmember from District III, has spoken with country-western singer George Strait, and Mr. Strait has offered to perform for the White Mountain Apache Tribe in a fund raising event; and
- WHEREAS,** George Strait came to the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for the Tribal Elk Hunt in 1991, and is planning on returning for the Elk Hunt this year; and
- WHEREAS,** Councilmember Massey would like the Tribal Council to offer Mr. Strait or some other celebrity one (1) elk hunt, gratis, in exchange for the celebrity's performance at a fund-raising concert, which Mr. Strait has indicated would be just and sufficient compensation for his services; and
- WHEREAS,** the White Mountain Apache Tribe, could earn approximately \$50,000 to \$100,000 from ticket sales for a George Strait concert at the Tribal Fairgrounds, which money would be distributed among all Districts to be used for community development and for the benefit of individual tribal members in need of assistance; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe supports Mr. Massey's efforts to raise funds for community development and tribal member assistance and a concert by George Strait in Whiteriver has the potential to ear a substantial sum for the Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports Mr. Massey's efforts to bring George Strait or some other celebrity to the Fort Apache Indian Reservation to perform at a fund raising concert in Whiteriver, and the Tribal Council hereby requests that Mr. Strait or another celebrity be given one (1) Tribal Elk Hunt, gratis, in exchange for his performance at a concert in Whiteriver, Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of five for and four against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
