- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby designates September 24, 1992 as the official staff picnic and mandates attendance for the Tribal Council and for Business, Executive and Human Resource staff, pursuant to the itinerary of schedule events attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference herein.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs every department supervisor or manager to post this resolution in their respective offices.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 10, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
