RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, District II Councilmember Kino Kane on behalf of the Carrizo Community, has verbally presented a petition from the community requesting authorization from the Tribal Council to withdraw \$400.00 from the Carrizo Community Land Claim Funds to sponsor a Halloween Party; and
- WHEREAS, Councilmember Kane avows that he will file a written petition with signatures to the Tribal Council Secretary; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with this request.
- whereas, Councilmember Kane acknowledges concerns that said funds should be utilized in conformity with the distribution formula of 22-D which requires that monies be expended for recreational purposes.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the withdrawal of \$400.00 from the Carrizo Land Claims Fund for the purpose of sponsoring a Halloween Party.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it reminds the Carrizo Community that the Carrizo Land Claims Fund is for recreational purposes and uses.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 30, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
