


**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** Veterans Day, Wednesday, November 11, 1992 has customarily been a tribal holiday for the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** it has been suggested that the holiday which is now in the middle of the week be celebrated on Friday, November 13, 1992.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby declares that Wednesday, November 11, 1992 will be a regular work day for employees of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and that Veterans Day shall be celebrated on Friday, November 13, 1992.

The foregoing resolution was on November 04, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
