- WHEREAS, more than ten days has transpired and the Tribal Council must therefore reaffirm said resolution.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms Resolution No. 10-92-299 amending the Tribal Budget for FY 92/93.
