

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


WHEREAS, Councilmember Slim Quay advises the Tribal Council that there is no longer a pay telephone available for the use of FATCO employees and there is only one pay telephone available for use of the Cedar Creek community; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Quay requests approval for pay telephones at both locations; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that pay telephones should be installed for the use of FATCO employees and the Upper Cedar Creek community.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Chairman or his designee to request GTE West to install two pay telephones, the first at FATCO and the second at Upper Cedar Creek.

The foregoing resolution was on November 12, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
