RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, the Tribal Council wishes to express its deep sorrow for the recent tragedy which has taken the lives of Roxanna Henry and her grandson, Joshua Jerome Dazen, on the morning of December 13, 1992; and
- WHEREAS, the fire which took the lives of Roxanna Henry and Joshua Jerome Dazen, age 11, also destroyed all the personal possessions of the Henry family and has left them destitute; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that funds should be provided or necessary supplies provided to the family members of the late Roxanna Henry.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Tribal Chairman, Ronnie Lupe, to allocate funds and necessary supplies for the family members of the late Roxanna Henry as is appropriate to meet their needs.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 14, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
