

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Tribal Council Member Kino Kane, on behalf of the Forestdale Community is requesting Tribal Council permission to utilize \$400 of the Forestdale Community Land Claims Fund for a Christmas party and gifts for young persons up to the age of 18 and elders over the age of 55; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Kane advises the Tribal Council that he will submit a petition of support of said request within ten (10) days of approval of the request; and

WHEREAS, Tribal Council concurs with the request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Forestdale Community to expend \$400 from the community's land claims fund for a Christmas party for young person up to the age of 18 and for elders over the age of 55 and to purchase gifts for said party.

The foregoing resolution was on December 14, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
