RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that U.S. Navy Seal Alvin Gregg has been visiting family on the reservation over the holidays while on leave from the Navy; and
- WHEREAS, Alvin Gregg was able to take unexpected leave to visit his family but it was necessary to spend all his money on bus fare; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Gregg must return to Northfork, Virginia where he is stationed and is requesting a loan from the Tribal Council for his return fare; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council concludes that the request for a loan to provide return fare for Mr. Gregg should be granted.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appropriates funds from the Chairman's Public Relations fund for the purpose of assisting Navy Seal Alvin Gregg with his return fare to Northfork, Virginia.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 06, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
